1 What problems did Brazil and India face after independence?

- Ans** (i) Brazil was under Portuguese rule for more than three centuries, whereas India was under the British rule for almost one and half centuries.
- (ii) After independence India had to face three wars, famine situation in various parts of the country and similar other issues.
- (iii) Whereas, Brazil was under populist military government, from 1930 to 1985 for nearly half a century, so it overcame its global financial difficulties in the late 20th Century.

2 Gather information about forts, considering the following points for it, determination of location period of construction, construction style and security mechanism.

Ans Maharashtra has famous forts like Raigad fort, Daulatabad fort, Shivneri fort, Pratapgad fort, Janjira fort, Sinhagad fort, Panhala fort.

- i. All these forts are located on the top of the mountains and have magnificent architecture and topography.
- ii. Fort like Janjira is built in the Arabian sea to witness the naval competence of Maratha regime.
- iii. Most of the forts either built or captured by Marathas between 12 to 15 century.
- iv. Forts reflect the valour of Shivaji, his foresight and skills in building forts.
