- 1 India receives precipitation from the North East monsoon winds.
- Ans i. After September the Temperature starts reducing in the north and air pressure starts rising.
  - ii. The winds start blowing from north towards south towards Indian ocean.
  - While blowing over the east coast, winds pickup moisture from the Bay of Bengal and give rain in the eastern coast.
- 2 There are no West flowing rivers in Brazil.
- Ans i. There is high elevation in the Western margin of Brazil and its slopes towards the East.
  - ii. Major rivers of Brazil a rising from Andes mountains, Guyana highlands and Brazilian Highlands.
  - iii. These rivers flows West to East.

- 2 Compare the climate of Brazil and India.
- **Ans** India lies in northern hemisphere and most part of Brazil in southern hemisphere. So the climate is completely opposite.

i. Both the country have tropical climate. But in Brazil has summer from October to April and winter from May to September. In India the summers are from April to September and winter from October to March.

ii. Brazil gets rainfall from South-east and North-east Trade winds but India gets rainfall from South-

west and North-east monsoon winds.

iii. India gets orographic rainfall throughout the country. The coastal areas in Brazil gets orographic rain but Amazon basic gets convectional rainfall.

iv. Jammu and Kashmir and mountains regions of Himalayas receive precipitation in the form of snow in winter. But in Brazil there is no snowfall.

v. Brazil coast doesn't experience cyclones. India experience cyclones and floods frequently.
